The **Carrie Adams Memorial Scholarship** was established by Carrie's parents, Chuck and Cheryl Adams in Carrie's memory. Carrie graduated in the Class of 1991. This scholarship recognizes students for their character and concern for their fellow students. Scholarships are awarded to a St. Philip graduate to provide financial assistance with their college educational expenses.

The **Sheila Guerra Memorial Scholarship** honors the memory of Sheila Guerra, former St. Philip teacher and volleyball coach. The Sheila Guerra Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a St. Philip graduate to provide financial assistance with their secondary educational expenses. The Sheila Guerra Memorial Scholarship recognizes graduates of St. Philip Catholic Central High School for outstanding academic achievement, demonstrated leadership and service to others and commitment to St. Philip School.

The **John B. and Margaret A. (Skaggs) Hogan Medical Scholarship** was established by John B. Hogan, Class of 1939 and Margaret (Skaggs) Hogan, Class of 1942. The purpose is to provide endowed support for an annual merit-based scholarship for one St. Philip Catholic Central High School graduate pursuing a college degree in an area of study related to health care.

The **Al Leibert Family Scholarship** was established by longtime coach and mentor, AL Leibert. This college scholarship is awarded to a St. Philip Catholic Central High School senior who has participated in athletics for all four years of high school.

The **Frank Quartermaine Scholar Athlete Scholarship** was established by the family of Frank Quartermaine, Class of 1961. This scholarship recognizes graduates who lettered in varsity athletics for at least two years while maintaining a 3.0 grade point average.

The **Valella Scholarship** was established by Michelle T. Valella, O.D. in May 2000 to recognize St. Philip High School graduates for their outstanding academic achievement, leadership and service to others during their years at St. Philip High School.
