

St. Philip Catholic Central High School Distinguished Alumni

Purpose:

The Distinguished Alumni Award at St. Philip Catholic Central High School honors alumnus/alumna who have transformed their high school experience into distinguished careers and lives of service demonstrating excellence in the arts, academics, ministry within the Church or service for their community or to the St. Philip School community.

Recipients must also possess the highest standards of integrity and character which reflect positively and enhance the prestige of St. Philip Catholic Central High School.

Eligibility:

All nominees must be alumnus/alumna of St. Philip High School and at least 30 years of age at the time of the nomination.

Awards may be given posthumously and, in such circumstances, there shall be no age requirement.

Criteria:

To be selected for induction, alumnus/alumna must have achieved significant milestones through their career, community involvement and service or professional and personal affiliations.

Individuals must have contributed to the continued success of St. Philip School

Nominations:

Any alumnus/alumna, friend or member of the selection committee may submit a nomination for St. Philip Catholic Central High School Distinguished Alumni.

Nominations are due five months prior to the Distinguished Alumni Recognition Event.

Nominations will be retained in the active file for one year.

Call for nominations will be published at minimum through the local media, in the alumni news and BCACS website.

Selection Process:

1. Nominations will be screened by the Selection Committee at a regularly scheduled meeting to be held four months prior to the formal induction ceremony.
2. All nominations will be considered in an open ballot. Nominees must receive a minimum of three votes to be considered for the Distinguished Alumni Ballot.
3. Nominees receiving the minimum of three votes or more will be included in a written and secret ballot. There is no limit to the number of nominees that may appear on the ballot.

4. Each selection committee member may vote for up to a maximum of five nominees, however, may vote for less than five.
5. There is no annual minimum or maximum for the number of Distinguished Alumni Honorees per year.
6. The nominees receiving five or more votes on the final ballot will be honored as a Distinguished Alumni.

Honorees are asked to make every effort to be present at the Distinguished Alumni Recognition event.

Selection Committee:

The Distinguished Alumni Selection Committee is a standing committee made up of seven members including: Principal, one staff member, Alumni Association president, Alumni Association Liaison to the BCACS Foundation and three former Distinguished Alumni honorees.

Members of the selection committee must agree to be present at each of the selection meetings held.
